Before we ca	an comply with your instructions to levy on <u>real property</u> , you must comply with the following:
	You must <i>specifically</i> instruct the Sheriff to:WRIT OF EXECUTION – "levy and sell ATTACHMENT – "attach
	all of the right, title and interest of in that real property described as"
	Supply our office with the names and addresses of all record owners of the property.
	Specifically tell our office if there is or is not a dwelling located on the property. If there is, is it real or personal property?
	Provide a typewritten legal description of the real property on a separate sheet of paper and supply our office with six (6) copies of the same.
	_ Supply original writ (or original electronic writ and writ declaration) plus six (6) copies.
	Supply the Assessor's Parcel Number(s) for the parcel(s) and a MAP indicating where the parcel(s) is/are located.
Other:	For writ of execution or sale, \$1,800.00 fee deposit per parcel payable to the Kern Co Sheriff.
	For writ of attachment, \$600.00 fee deposit payable to the Kern Co Sheriff.
	A check for recording fees made payable to the Kern Co Recorder will be required prior to the recording of the levy. You will be contacted with the amount required.
	An original certified copy of the judgment and order is required with a writ of sale. A copy of the right to attach, undertaking, and debtor's mailing address is required with a writ of attachment

Provide a breakdown of costs per parcel, if more than one parcel, under a writ of sale and sold

per State & Hwy Code.
