

Driving in Foggy Conditions

If you must drive in foggy conditions, keep the following safety tips in mind:

- Slow down and allow extra time to reach your destination.
- Make your vehicle visible to others, both ahead of you and behind you, by using your low-beam headlights. This will also turn your taillights on. Use fog lights if you have them.
- Remember your automatic headlights may not turn on in the fog.
- Never use your high-beam lights. Using high beam lights causes glare, making it more difficult for you to see what is ahead of you on the road.
- Use the right edge of the road as a guide. This helps you stay in your lane and not "drift" into the middle lane.
- Roll down your window. This allows you to listen for cars and emergency vehicles.
- Use roadside reflectors as a guide. The markings can help you navigate twists and turns
- Leave plenty of distance between you and the vehicle in front of you to account for sudden stops or changes in the traffic pattern.
