Driving in Foggy Conditions

If you must drive in foggy conditions, keep the following safety tips in mind:

- **Slow down** and allow extra time to reach your destination.
- **Make your vehicle visible** to others, both ahead of you and behind you, by using your low-beam headlights. This will also turn your taillights on. Use fog lights if you have them.
- **Remember your automatic headlights may not turn on in the fog.**
- **Never use your high-beam lights.** Using high beam lights causes glare, making it more difficult for you to see what is ahead of you on the road.
- **Use the right edge of the road as a guide.** This helps you stay in your lane and not "drift" into the middle lane.
- **Roll down your window.** This allows you to listen for cars and emergency vehicles.
- **Use roadside reflectors as a guide.** The markings can help you navigate twists and turns
- **Leave plenty of distance** between you and the vehicle in front of you to account for sudden stops or changes in the traffic pattern.
