Language Access Survey

Section VI of the Stipulated Judgment covers language access for communication and community services for those with limited English proficiency.

The Sheriff's Office has agreed to effectively communicate with and provide timely and meaningful access to law enforcement services to all members of the Kern County community, regardless of their limited ability to speak, read, write, or understand English. To achieve this, the Sheriff's Office has agreed to work with the Community Advisory Council (CAC) and community stakeholders to develop and implement a language access policy consistent with Title VI to provide meaningful access to the Sheriff's Office programs and services for individuals with limited English proficiency.

A survey was developed to assess the Sheriff's Office's capacity to provide services to individuals with limited English proficiency. The Sheriff's Office also aims to identify any barriers preventing employees with translation abilities from being certified through the County of Kern. The survey will compile a list of bilingual employees, including their additional languages spoken and their certification status or intention to become certified.
