Axon Standards Release

On September 30, 2025, Axon Records Management System (RMS) will be released and replace the Kern County Sheriff's Office records management system. Axon Standards will go live on the same date and replace our current systems, IAPro and BlueTeam, which track and record personnel use of force and complaints. Axon Standards will be the system personnel will use to record use of force entries/reviews, vehicle accidents, pursuit reports (including completion of the CHP 187 form), field complaints, and many of the Internal Affairs processes. Axon Standards entries closely resemble the Axon RMS system, making it easy for staff who participated in the in-person Axon RMS training to adapt quickly.

To prepare for the launch of the new system, training has been developed to assist users with making entries, reviewing reports, and generally navigating the system. The training has been broken down into two blocks:

Block #1

1. Defining Axon Standards
2. Navigating Standards
3. Modules Overview
4. Search
5. Writing a Report

Block #2

1. Reviewing a Report
2. Case Management
3. Early Intervention System (EIS)

Anyone responsible for making entries into BlueTeam will be required to participate in **Block #1** of the Axon Standards training (e.g., Deputy Sheriffs, Detentions Deputies, Deputy Coroners, Park Rangers, Community Service Technicians, etc.).

Supervisors and managers will be required to participate in both **Block #1 and Block #2.**

The training can be accessed via [Axon Standards Training](#). Additionally, it will be available on the SheriffNet Axon RMS page, allowing personnel to revisit the videos as needed. See below on how to log in to the training.

All personnel are required to review the training videos and acknowledge this training bulletin no later than **Tuesday, September 30, 2025.**

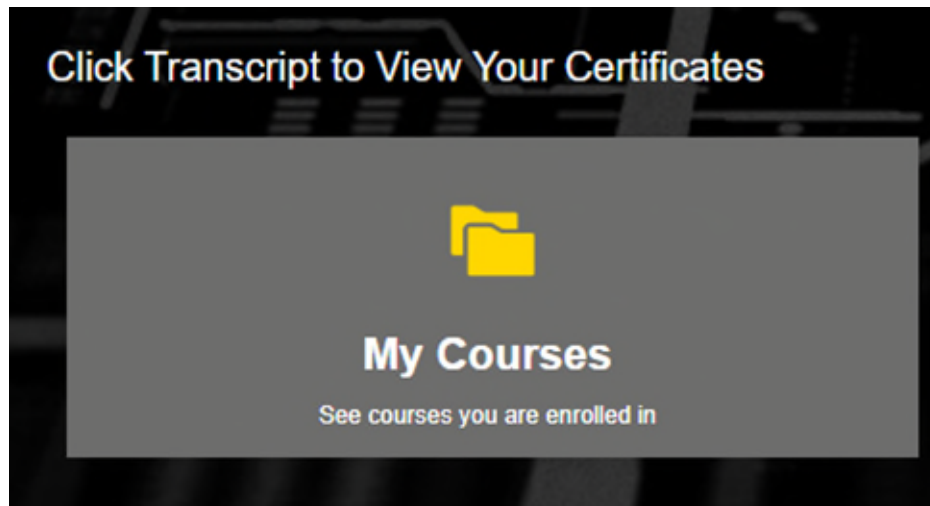

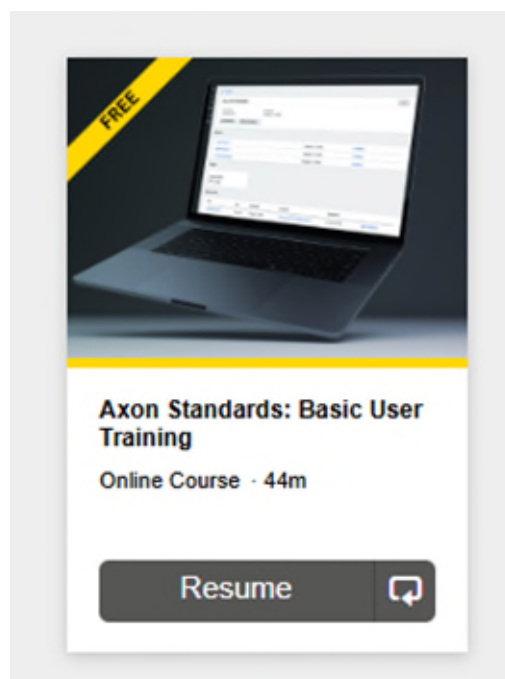
