2025 Fourth Quarter Bias-Free Policing Training: Loggervale et al v. County of Alameda et al

As good practice and for the Fourth Quarter of 2025, personnel are required to review the body-worn camera footage of an Alameda County Deputy Steven Holland's contact with Aasylei Loggervale and her two daughters, a short new clip discussing the outcome of the federal lawsuit filed in relation to the law enforcement contact, KCSOPPM J-2300, and complete a 10-question quiz.

The first video depicts the law enforcement contact between Deputy Holland and the Loggervales. In summary, Deputy Holland contacts Ms. Loggervale and her two daughters seated in a vehicle outside of a local Starbucks where recent vehicle burglaries had occurred. Deputy Holland proceeds to ask for the driver's identification without any other apparent articulable facts that tend to show that anything criminal was occurring. Ms. Loggervale declines to provide identification, citing that there was no criminal activity occurring. The contact escalates with Deputy Holland forcibly removing Ms. Loggervale from the vehicle and taking her into custody while another deputy detains her daughters.

The second video is a news clip which highlights the fact that a federal jury awarded the occupants of the vehicle \$8.25 million dollars because of the unlawful detention and civil rights violation(s).

All personnel in the Deputy Sheriff and Park Ranger ranks are required to review the videos and policy in the link listed below for further details. After reviewing the material, personnel are required to take a knowledge test and pass with a score of 100%.
